

books.papers.documentries.newspaper and magazine articles and reams of radio and television programs about it. This book is probably the latest one that proposes a solution to the riddle that has fired the imagination, driven men to ruin, and even death in trying to answer the guestion; what's down there? I have been following the story of Oak Island ever since my days in High School in the early 1950's. I even visited the island when there was a lull in searching, sometime in the early 60's. While there has never beel very many years when someone was trying to solve the mystery, and there was always some artifact or whatever that continued to be found; and so , even though the "evidence" continues to mount; the answer still eludes solving. I wrote a Review on one of the more extensive books about this story,"The Lost Treasure of The Knights Templar" by Steven Sora on August 26,2008.
