Like many of these books, it started out with a good premise: a comic book store employee accuses a young woman of not being a true fan and calls her basically a c\*\*k tease and so forth. As revenge she casts a spell that slowly turns him into a woman. So you're thinking that now the shoe will be on the other foot and he'll be a young woman accused of not being a true geek by other guys. Nah. It never gets there. Instead he turns into a woman all the way and instantly decides he really wants to be called Claire and wear dresses and makeup and go to a lesbian club to pick up girls. Um...really?

It was not a believable turn and pretty much sunk the story. The epilogue starts to get it back on track, but this could--and should--all have been done in one story.
