

I understand now why this edition is so cheap, even cheaper than used versions of the previous edition. The loose-leaf version is printed on glossy newsprint, which make it much less durable. The pictures, charts, margin notes, and in-text highlights are all black-and-white, which decreases their readability and usefulness. And the e-text further decreases the value. The in-text glossary is decent, and the other interactive features would be pretty good if they weren't so slow to load and inclined to freeze. The highlighting feature is just about the worse I've ever seen in an e-book; instead of a simple trace over the text, you have to resize a rectangular text-box, which takes forever. The interface is so glitchy; the highlights boxes randomly duplicate or disappear, which ultimately makes them useless for studying. But the worst thing about the e-text is that the product description doesn't tell you that you only get a six-month access subscription. That's fine if you're only using it for a grad-school literacy methods class, but if you want to use it as a resource once you're actually in the classroom, you're out of luck.It's actually a very good text. The material is comprehensive, well-written, and accessible. It includes lots of tips, strategies, and examples, including several complete lesson plans in every chapter to highlight the instructional practices and techniques described in each section. The chapters also include specific differentiation for English language learners. The margin notes include ways for integrating technology, software and Internet resources, and related CCSS. The information in this book makes it a great resource for aligning literacy instruction to new standards. Too bad the publication doesn't allow it to be used that way.

Personal note - special educators should read research findings with a grain of salt, as they don't necessarily apply neatly to our students.

This book in paperback is only available hardbound from the publisher or from other U.S. outlets. The UCTQ rates this as the most frequently used text in top teacher preparation programs. This paperback version is a real catch at half the price. Too bad my university distribution did not allow me to order for my entire class. The paperback version comes from the UK.

At first, I was annoyed by it because it was pretty flimsy. However, I grew to like it because I could take out the chapter I had to read and take it with me. It was much easier to carry a section of the text in my purse vs. the entire book. Hopefully you find that helpful if you purchase that version, too.
