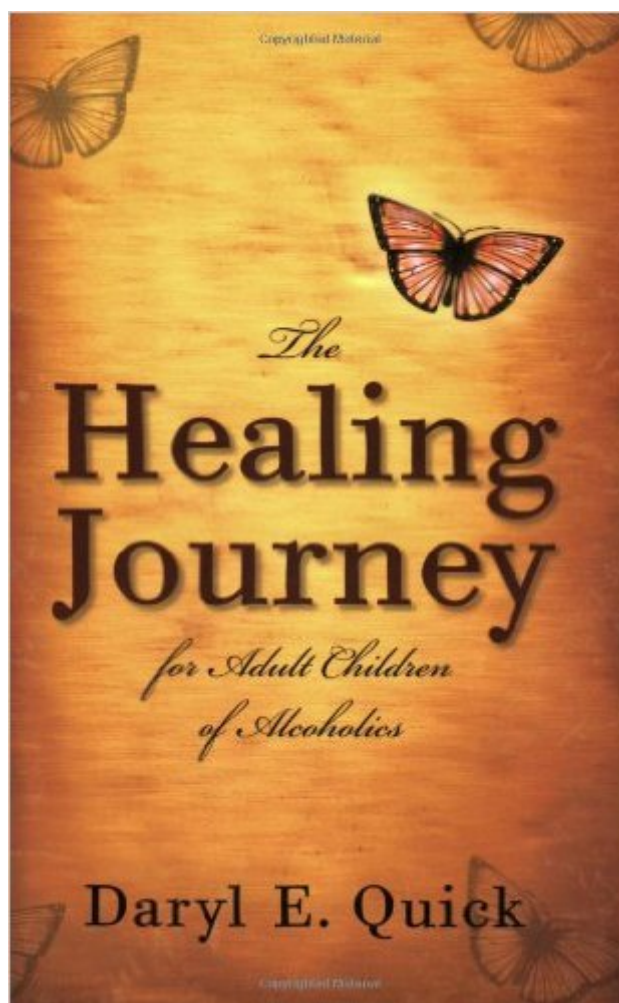

As an adult-child of an alcoholic who has been sober for 6 years, I can say I never truly understood the many ways that my parent's alcoholism affected my life and the way I interact with people. It was recommended to me that I read this book while I was going through sorority recruitment my freshman year of college after I bonded with one of my now sorority sisters over our parent's troubled histories. She told me the many ways this book had worked for her and suggested I check it out. This book helped me identify problem areas in my life and in my behaviors to understand what the problem is, why it came about, how to fix it, and how to heal myself. The author does a great job of addressing the fact that no two people have the same experiences in a troubled household (whether it be from abuse, alcoholism, or some other type of addiction) but that many times they suffer and cope in similar ways. Many of the messages hit very close to home for me and made me realize that I was not alone. It made me feel supported, which, as someone who tends to internalize my issues and not reach out for help when I need it, was very comforting and reassuring. It is not the most grammatically correct book, but the message is helpful, impactful, and straightforward. Definitely worth purchasing if you are struggling to understand your family member's illness in relation to your own life.

This is one of the best books I've read for acoa information AND for the starting of my healing. It has caused real progress in me and given me other methods of healing.
